Item #1: Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

Item #2: Prohibiting Cell Phone Usage in School Zones

Chief Bates updated the Public Safety Committee (PSC) in regard to the new state law which prohibits the use of cell phones in school zones within certain provisions while permitting certain exceptions. Brad Neighbor, City Attorney, discussed the legal issues surrounding the new law recently enacted by the state legislature. Robert Wunderlich, Managing Director of Transportation, discussed the issues involved with the required implementation of new signs in school zones. The committee voted unanimously to take no further action at this time.

Item #3: Possibility of Groups or Organizations Leasing Police Vehicles

Chief Bates and City Attorney Brad Neighbor discussed the procedural and legal issues involved in leasing police vehicles to groups or organizations. The discussion was informational only. No further action was requested at this time.
